## Larrain facilitates Chilean firefighting effort

Larrain y Asociados Abogados in Chile has helped non-profit organisation Fundación Viento Sur bring a specialist aircraft from Colorado-based Global SuperTanker Services to Chile to help fight raging wildfires across the country.

The operation of the Global SuperTanker, the world's most advanced aerial firefighter, began on 24 January. The initial mission was funded by a donation of a reported US\$2 million from Viento Sur, part of the non-profit Walton Family Foundation that was established by the founders of Walmart.

Chile's Luksic family also made a donation to prolong the tanker's efforts for an additional week. It returned to the US on 13 February.

The wildfires have destroyed approximately 1 million acres of land and over 1,000 homes. President Michelle Bachelet called it "the greatest forest disaster in Chilean history".
