PPU and Larrain close Chilean renewables buy

<u>Philippi Prietocarrizosa Ferrero DU & Uría (Chile)</u> has helped the renewables arm of European energy company EDF buy 50 per cent of a Chilean solar power plant developer.

The seller, Andes Mining & Energy, hired Larrain y Asociados. It retains the remaining 50 per cent of Santiago Solar's stock.

Santiago Solar is developing a 115-megawatt solar plant in Tiltil, central Chile.

EDF Energies Nouvelles paid US\$2 million for the shares and agreed to contribute US\$25 million to finance construction of the project. Santiago Solar also plans to obtain a further US\$120 million in funding for the power plant.

The acquisition closed on 2 September.
